The accreditation process as outlined by NCA / WCEA requires Our Lady of Perpetual Help Catholic School to complete a Self-Study addressing a number of different criteria.

The Steering Committee facilitates the process of completing the Self-Study.

The product of the Self-Study is a book that addresses the criteria outlined by NCA/WCEA. Each of the criteria is addressed by a different committee made up of faculty members.

The committee, Organization for Student Learning, examines the school's philosophy and mission statements, governance, school leadership, staff, school environment, reporting student progress, and the school improvement process.

The committee, Curriculum and Instruction, examines what students learn, how students learn, and how assessment is used.

The committee, Support for Student Personal, Spiritual, and Academic Growth, examines student connectedness and parent/community involvement.

The committee, Resource Management and Development, examines resources and resource planning.

Our committees are in the initial stages of drafting the report. Once the drafts are complete and revised, each committee will be reviewing the work of every other committee. By the time the Self-Study is finished, every member of our faculty will have read and provided feedback on every section of the report. Some sections of the Self-Study will also be reviewed by the Parent Advisory Board and other members of our community.
