### An update on the NCA/WCEA Accreditation Process

#### “Who are ‘They?’”

Part of the NCA/WCEA accreditation process requires that an Accreditation Visiting Team visit our school to verify our compliance and growth with NCA/WCEA’s guidelines and criteria. The Visiting Team is usually chaired by an administrator from out of state, and the team itself is composed of educators from right here in the state of Arizona. Their job is to simply verify what, we as a community, have said that we are doing in our Self-Study. They will spend three days with us, November 11-13, 2008. They will be walking around campus, visiting classrooms, speaking with administrators, teachers, parents, and students. They, in turn, will compose a report, similar to ours, simply affirming the growth we have made and the areas we have chosen to be strengthened over the next several years. That report will then be presented to the staff on the last day of their visit.
