In addition, the teachers will meet with the Visiting Team separate from the Leadership Team. The Visiting Team will want to hear about what we are doing at our school, what our schoolwide Student Learning Expectations are, how our students are achieving in relation to the school Student Learning Expectations, etc. It is simply a conversation about who we are and what we do that will be used as evidence to support our Self-Study.
