Dear Parents,

Thank you for your response to the first of two Flu Clinics at OLPH. The Mollen Clinic staff was so impressed with your children's cooperation and respectful behavior. They will be returning to our school for a second clinic on 1/8/2010 9:00:00 AM to 12:00:00 PM). The purpose of this second clinic is to reach:

- Students who have not received the H1N1 Swine Flu vaccination.
- Students who have not receive their annual vaccination for seasonal flu for 2009.
- Students who need a second dose of the H1N1 Swine Flu and/or seasonal flu vaccination.
- School staff and administration that have not received their H1N1 Swine Flu vaccine or the annual seasonal flu vaccine for 2009.

• **Special Note for younger Students related to vaccinations:**

1. As recommended by the Center for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC), Students **9 years of age and younger** should receive a **second dose of H1N1 Swine Flu** vaccine. The CDC recommends the second dose should be administered approximately **28 days** after the first dose.
2. As recommended by the Center for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC), Students **8 years of age and younger** should receive a **second dose of Seasonal Flu** vaccine. The CDC recommends the second dose should be administered approximately **28 days** after the first dose.

Please refer to the following page for instructions on how to register for the clinic next month. To ensure that your child receives the vaccine, pre-register and send a copy of your registration to my office. I appreciate your dedication to keeping our students healthy.

Pre-register your children for an H1N1 vaccination at our school by following the steps out-lined below.

STEPS:

1. Log onto: www.FluShotsUSA.com/schools
 2. Select our school district (CATHOLIC SCHOOLS - DIOCESE OF PHOENIX) and school Our Lady of Perpetual Help School (Scottsdale) and then enter information as prompted
 3. Print out the confirmation / consent form for each of your children

General Information for Our Lady of Perpetual Help School (Scottsdale)

Parents:

- Immunizations will be provided by Mollen Immunization Clinics in conjunction with Maricopa County Health Department and our School District
- Most health insurance plans and AHCCCS plans are accepted with no co-payment for the H1N1 immunizations
- No child without insurance will be denied the H1N1 vaccination
- Thorough screening questions are used to ensure that each child is administered the appropriate vaccine
- Registration is currently available in English and Spanish
- Bring in a copy of his/her signed consent form**
- You will receive a verification of the vaccine administered via e-mail
- You may select to have the record of the vaccine administered forwarded to your child's Doctor
