Tuition Payment Options

FULL PAYMENT:

The entire amount of tuition and fees is paid on or before June 10, 2011. The payment is made directly to the School Office.

SEMI-ANNUAL PAYMENT:

The tuition payment and fees will be divided into two payments. The 1st payment is due June 10, 2011 and the 2nd payment is due December 10, 2011. The payments are made directly to the School Office.

MONTHLY FACTS PAYMENTS:

Tuition is paid over a 12-month period through the FACTS Monthly Automatic Tuition Payment Plan. The payment plan begins June 2011.

NEW THIS YEAR: Enrollment in the FACTS Tuition Management Plan is now submitted on-line through the FACTS link on OLPH website: www.olphaz.com/school. This new program allows each family the opportunity to directly manage their FACTS account. Please see the attached forms for step-by-step instructions in setting up your FACTS Payment Plan.

A copy of the FACTS Confirmation page MUST be attached to your contract.

***A Parish Verification Form for families requesting the Catholic tuition discount rate must be returned with your contract to receive the discounted tuition rate.**

2011-2012 Tuition Policies

REGISTRATION FEE

There will be a \$50 NON-REFUNDABLE late registration fee per student for contract packages received in the office after April 20th. This fee will not be applied to tuition.

1. Students will **not be assigned to a class** for the 2011-2012 school year until registration is complete.
2. Registration is **not complete** until the Registration Contract, FACTS Confirmation Page (if applicable), and Parish Verification Form have been received in the school office.
3. Each family is asked to meet the Annual Tuition Rate, if possible.

PARISH SCHOLARSHIPS

For those families who are registered, active and participating members of OLPH Parish reduced tuition is available. A registered OLPH family is considered active and participating if a minimum of \$600 has been received through weekly offertory envelopes during the fiscal year, July 1, 2010—June 30, 2011. The tuition reduction is granted as a Parish Scholarship of \$520. It becomes effective when the Registration Contract and Parish Verification form is signed and received in the school office.

For those families who are registered, active and participating members of another Catholic Parish, reduced tuition is available per the 2011-2012 Tuition Rate sheet. It becomes effective when the Registration Contract and Parish Verification form is signed and received in the school office.
