Springfest Raffle greetings!

In previous years, the raffle competition targeted the individual instead of the family. While there were a handful of exceptional student sellers, a large percentage of raffle revenue resulted from parents purchasing or selling tickets. This commitment from parents was unrewarded and created the burden of keeping numbers equal between siblings so that rewards targeted at the individual could be earned by each child. This year, after your family minimum requirement is satisfied, each child of the family will earn the reward indicated by the raffle guidelines. In addition, the cost of the raffle ticket and the number of tickets per family have been reduced. With these changes, we hope that 100% of families will satisfy their minimum and find it easier to accomplish. Following is a summary that outlines the goal of the Raffle Committee.
